

Application for 2010 Oak Ridges Moraine Private Land Restoration Projects

CRITERIA:

- Funding is available to Ontario-based not-for-profit organizations, municipalities, conservation authorities, land trusts, universities, colleges and First Nations.
- Projects must be located on private land on the Moraine in either core or linkage designation.
- Project must already be confirmed to go ahead with a landowner agreement in place (please include a copy with your application) and all other supporting funds secured.
- Eligible projects include: forest, wetland, riparian or prairie plantings or restorations. Infrastructure costs will not be supported.
- Oak Ridges Moraine Foundation funding will cover a maximum of 1/3 of the total project costs up to \$2,000. Projects costs can include staff time associated directly with the project.
- All landowners must agree to display a Caring for the Moraine recognition sign on a publically visible portion of their property. This sign will be provided to you by the Foundation.
- Partners are encouraged to profile projects by any means possible. The Foundation will consider assisting with some of the costs associated with things such as website or print profiling (e.g. newspaper ads, features in newsletters). All material must be approved by the Foundation prior to its release.
- All applications must be submitted in **HARDCOPY** only. Please do not send electronic copies.
- You will be contacted by phone and by written correspondence to confirm the status of your application within two weeks of the receipt of your application.
- Foundation funds will be paid out once the project is completed. In order to facilitate payment the grantee must send a hardcopy letter to the Foundation stating that the project is completed and submit an updated copy of the application budget. At this time we will also require a CD with the shape file(s) for the restoration sites. If you do not have GIS capabilities internally you will be requested to enter your information into a secure area of the Stewardship Tracking System. Payments will not be made until this information is received.
- Funds are available on a first come first serve basis.
- An organization is eligible to receive a maximum of two grants in 2010 under the Oak Ridges Moraine Private Land Restoration program.
- Applications will be received until September 30, 2010.
- All projects must be completed and the required documentation submitted to the Foundation by November 30, 2010.
